There will be no school on Thursday, April 17th due to a Professional Development Day for our teachers.

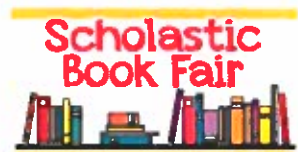
BOOK FAIR RETURNS TO EEE!
